

U. S. Bombers Blast Toulon

LONDON, Feb. 4.—(AP)—The Vichy radio said that Toulon, naval base on the southern coast of France, was raided at 2 P. M. today.

A British broadcast said that American bombers carried out heavy attacks on Toulon, the port of France, during the night of Feb. 3-4.

Describing the Toulon raid, the Vichy radio said that two waves of bombers flew over the harbor and the city.

The number of victims and the damage, which was not higher than that in the raid of Nov. 24, is not known.

LONDON, Feb. 4.—(AP)—Great forces of American heavy bombers landed out at N. E. Europe for the seventh time in eight days today, according to a report from the British Ministry of Defense.

The preliminary announcement gave no indication of the targets, but it was obvious that the bombers in the North Sea were blasting a succession of explosive bombs on the coast of France.
